

REACH REGISTRATION STATUS

Horizons Incorporated, through its Imaging Systems Group, imports into the European Union a line of preparations commonly used in the manufacture of labels, nameplates, and placards.

In order to create the image on these articles, some require the intentional release of substances during processing. These articles include:

- ***Metalphoto® Photosensitive Aluminum***
- ***AlumaMark® Laser Markable Aluminum***
- ***DuraBlack® Laser Markable Aluminum***
- ***ID-Mark® Photosensitive Aluminum***
- ***ID-Mark® Photosensitive Polyester***
- ***PolyColor® plates and sheets***

The total amount of individual substances imported into the European Union from these preparations is less than 1 ton per year, so no registration of the substances is required.

No intentional release occurs from the following articles:

- ***AlumaJet® Ink Jet Printable Aluminum***
- ***EconAlum® anodized-only material***
- ***VinylJet® Waterproof Ink Jet Printable Vinyl***

We wish to emphasize that these preparations are only used in the processing stages of articles manufactured by Horizons Inc. involving image creation and sealing of anodized aluminum. No intentional release of these preparations occurs in fully processed sheets or in the finished article.

The preparations listed above contain neither any of the substances mentioned in the Candidate List under Annex XIV as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) (as of 1/21/2025), nor substances restricted under the Restriction list under Annex XVII (as of 1/21/2025) at a concentration above 0.1%.
